The exchange rates we offer do not include any fees within the rate of exchange. Rather, we apply a separate percentage-based fee as set out below, which is also shown separately in the Revolut app whenever you make an exchange.

HIGH-FREQUENCY STANDARD CUSTOMERS

Different fees apply for high-frequency standard customers. A high-frequency standard customer is someone who:

- is a standard customer (not a premium or metal user); and
- has exchanged ¥750,000 (or the equivalent in a different currency) in any rolling month (Standard Exchange Allowance).

For a high-frequency standard customer, a higher fee of 0.5% shall apply to any aggregate amount exchanged over the Standard Exchange Allowance. You can find your remaining Standard Exchange Allowance for the current 30 day period displayed in the Revolut app at any time.
